8. Project plan review.

The City-County Public Works Authority will review all plans and specifications of all proposed extensions or developments. An owner or developer will pay a one-time fee of \$100.00 per ERU or as negotiated pursuant to a Utility Service Agreement. Project plans will not be approved until full payment of fee is received.

- 9. Project inspection.
 - All projects must be inspected by the City-County Public Works Authority and the owner or developer shall pay fees at the rate of \$25.00, due upon permit application.
- 10. Miscellaneous charges for services not included above. Actual costs of material and labor required plus an administrative charge of fifteen percent (15%) or \$25.00, whichever is greater, to be determined by the City-County Public Works Authority.
- 11. Fee on delinquent accounts.

 Ten percent (10%) per month on delinquent amount due to date account is closed, not to exceed three (3) consecutive monthly charge periods.
